Come join us as the Manager of Women's Events where you will manage women's team matches along with casual and fun women's tournaments, events and programs aimed at overall player development. You will have the opportunity to work with the Member Services team, Member Club representatives and Mass Golf volunteers to promote and ensure a positive experience for players, participants and host clubs for all events and programs.

Duties & Responsibilities:

- Responsible for leading and evaluating the Women's Tournament and Event Program, as
 well as training and managing the game day staff, interns and volunteers associated with
 all events.
- Administrative management of Women's Tournaments and Events including online registration, player support, pre-event communication and coordination with participants and host club staff.
- Administrative management of Women's Spring and Fall team matches including online registration, captain and club staff support, pre-event communication and coordination with captains throughout the season.
- Coordinates and performs on-site tournament duties including event management and course set-up, registration, starting, monitoring pace of play and scoring.
- Responsible for Women's Tournaments and Events site procurement.
- Responsible for managing one Member Services intern.
- Supports the Assistant Director of Member Services in managing and administering
 Mass Golf events and other industry initiatives that support and educate our Members,
 Member Clubs and Allied Associations on a wide range of programs and benefits.



- Develops and manages player development events, clinics, and play days designed to engage new and casual female golfers.
- Assists with other special projects as assigned by the Assistant Director of Member Services and Director of Member Services (i.e., meetings, seminars, and projects).
- Assists with regional Massachusetts team events on an as-needed basis.

Requirements:
