Format: Teams of two; 18 hole stroke play-better ball of partners @ 95% course handicap. In the event of a tie for first place (low gross), the champions will be decided by USGA recommended match of cards.

Historical Context of Tournament: The Eleanor I. LaBonte tournament originated in 1950 to commemorate the 50th anniversary of the WGAM. In February of 1972 it officially became the "The Eleanor I. LaBonte" tournament. Miss LaBonte served as Executive Secretary for the WGAM for over 25 years and was Handicap Chairperson for 33 years.

Rules of Play: The 2016 Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the [Mass Golf Hard Card](#). The Committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed at the tournament site. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the Conditions of the Competition.

Golf Carts, Caddies and Pull Carts: Golf carts are included in the Championship entry fee. Players are **strongly encouraged** to use golf carts during the tournament round. Caddies and/or push carts are permitted.

Time of Starting - 9am Shotgun Start. Please be at your golf cart and ready to play at 8:45 am.

Tees: All play from the Mass Golf tee markers with approximate yardage of 5,072 yds.

Practice Facilities: The use of practice facilities (mats only) is included in entry fee and will be open at 7:45 am.

Rest Rooms: Comfort stations are located between holes 6 & 7 and 12 & 13.

Food & Beverage Services: A buffet lunch will be provided by Mass Golf for all competitors upon completion of the round. A cash bar will be open. Limited snacks/drinks can be purchased in the pro shop.

Prizes: The winners of this event have the lowest gross score and their names will be engraved on the permanent trophy. Merchandise certificates will be awarded - only redeemable at the host site.
