Format: Four-Ball Stroke Play. 18 holes played each day. In the event of a tie for first place, a hole-by-hole play-off will commence immediately following the close of competition on the Port Course (Holes #10, 11 & 18).

Rules of Play: The 2016 Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the Mass Golf Hard Card. The Committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed at the Championship sites. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the Conditions of the Competition. A side's score to count must be individually identifiable. Partners that do not make a score on any particular hole should mark an "X".

Golf Carts, Caddies and Pull Carts: Golf carts are included in the Championship entry fee. Players are **strongly encouraged** to use golf carts during the Championship rounds. Caddies and/or push carts are permitted.

Time of Starting - Round 1 & 2: Play will begin at 7:45am and 12:15pm off the 1st and 10th tees. Please make sure to be at your starting tee at least 10 minutes prior to your starting time to ensure that all proper instructions are received from the starter. The clocks at the 1st and 10th tees are the official time.

 - o Practice rounds played outside of these times will be subject to full greens fees.

Notes

- Please contact the golf shop at (508) 896-1716 and identify yourself as a competitor in the field to schedule a practice round. Practice rounds MUST be scheduled in advance (no walk-ups will be permitted).
- There will be a MANADATORY \$21 cart/trail fee, per player, for their practice round.
- Discounted practice rounds are for COMPETITORS ONLY and only one ball may be played per competitor.
- All competitors will be permitted ONE discounted practice round per golf course (Port and Starboard).
- Please note that the Starboard Course was aerified on April 2 & 3 and the Port Course on April 9 & 10.

Championship Tees: Approximate yardage for the Championship Courses: Starboard Course: 6,600 yds. & Port Course: 6,600 yds.

Practice Facilities: The practice range will be open and available starting at 6:30am each day. For anyone interested in using the practice range <a href="mailto:after-afte

Please note that the practice facility is **NOT** accessible by golf cart. Players are encouraged to drive their own vehicle to the practice facility which is located .25 miles from the club's entrance. – **GPS Address** 111 Commerce Park Rd, Brewster, MA 02631

Due to ongoing construction work to the Sagamore Bridge, please plan your travel accordingly and seek an alternate route, if available. It is suggested that travel on/off Cape is done using the Bourne Bridge. The Sagamore Bridge work is scheduled to continue through May and may interrupt your travel during both championship days.
