Format: 18 holes, stroke play qualifying. The top <u>9 qualifiers and ties</u> will move on to the championship proper at Haverhill Country Club in Haverhill, MA on October 2-3, 2018. The number of qualifying spots is subject to change based on any withdrawals prior to the competition.

Rules of Play: The 2016 Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the <u>Mass Golf Hard Card</u>. The Committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed at the championship site. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the Conditions of the Competition.

Golf Carts: Golf carts are permitted for use during the qualifying round and are available at the player's expense - **\$20** per player (cash or credit).

1st Tee Time: Play will begin at 8:00am, in groups of three, at ten-minute intervals, off the 1st tee. Please be sure to be at <u>your starting tee at least 10 minutes prior</u> to ensure that all proper instructions are received from the starter.

Tees: Approximate yardage for the Qualifying Round will be 6,000 yards (Blue/White Tees).

Practice Round: A practice round can be scheduled by calling the golf shop and introducing yourself as a competitor in the qualifying round: **(508) 764-6290**. There will be a mandatory cart/trail fee of \$40 per player, for those choosing to ride during their practice round.

Club Facilities: The golf shop and clubhouse will be available at 7:30am. Lunch will be available at the player's expense starting at 11:00am

Practice Range Facilities: Will be open and available starting at 7:30am.

Score Posting: All scores from individual stroke play events (qualifiers & championships proper) will be automatically posted to a player's Mass Golf/USGA Handicap Index by the Mass Golf.
