Format: 54 holes, stroke play (18 holes per day), 150 +/- players, comprised of place-winners in qualifying rounds and those exempt from qualifying. The fifty (50) lowest scorers & ties or anyone within 7 strokes of the leader after 36-holes will continue play on June 13th.

Rules of Play: The 2016 Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the Mass Golf Hard Card. The Committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed at the Championship sites. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the Conditions of the Competition.

Policies & Procedures: Please refer to the Mass Golf Policies & Procedures page.

Golf Carts, Caddies and Pull Carts: Players may use caddies and/or pull/push carts during the Championship Proper. The use of automotive transportation is **NOT** permitted.

Time of Starting - Rounds 1, 2 & 3: Can be found on the Massachusetts Open Championship landing page. Please be sure to be at your assigned starting tee 10 minutes before your scheduled starting time. The starter's clock at the 1st & 10th tees is the official time.

Practice Round

Available Dates

Any weekday leading up to the championship proper. Tee times will be based on availability and you may be paired up with other competitors playing their practice round.

Notes

- Please contact the GreatHorse pro shop at (413) 566-2005 to schedule your practice round.
- There will be a mandatory cart/trail fee of \$30 per competitor and competitors are limited to one practice round.
 - Caddies may join competitors during their practice round as a caddie or have the option of playing at the guest fee of \$125.
- Competitors may warm-up on the practice range, short game area and practice putting green ahead of their practice round starting time.
- Only one ball may be played per competitor during their practice round.
- For players unable to take advantage of a practice round or wanting to preview the course again, you may WALK (no clubs) the course on Sunday, June 10th after 3:30pm.
 - The practice putting green & short game area will be available for competitors after 4:00pm on Sunday, June 10th
 - Competitors must provide their own balls when using the short game area.
 - The practice/driving range will be unavailable on Sunday, June 10th.

Practice Facilities: The practice/warm-up facilities will be open and available starting at 6:30am each day.

Food & Beverage: Will be available for purchase throughout the event in the clubhouse (cash or credit - credit preferred). Breakfast will be available 6:30am-10:00am, Lunch 10:00am-3:00pm & Dinner 3:00pm-9:00pm.

Purse/Prizes: The Clarence G. Cochrane Memorial Trophy will be presented to the Champion and The Commonwealth Cup will be presented to the Low-Amateur. A professional purse of \$75,000 will be distributed to the low fifty (50) finishers & ties. Merchandise certificates will also be awarded and are only redeemable at the host site.
