Format: 18 holes, stroke play qualifying. The top <u>14 qualifiers and ties</u> will move on to the championship proper at Haverhill Country Club in Haverhill, MA on October, 2-3, 2018. The number of qualifying spots is subject to change based on any withdrawals prior to the competition.

Rules of Play: The 2016 Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the <u>Mass Golf Hard Card</u>. The Committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed at the championship site. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the Conditions of the Competition.

Golf Carts: Golf carts are permitted for use during the qualifying round and are available at the player's expense - \$15 per player (cash or credit).

1st Tee Time: Play will begin at 7:30am, in groups of three, at nine-minute intervals, off the 1st tee. Please be sure to be at <u>your starting tee at least 10 minutes prior</u> to ensure that all proper instructions are received from the starter.

Tees: Approximate yardage for the Qualifying Round will be 6,100 yards (White/Blue Tees).

Practice Round: A practice round can be scheduled by calling the golf shop and introducing yourself as a competitor in the qualifying round: (978) 454-3405 x101. There will be a cart/trail fee of \$15 per player, for those choosing to ride during their practice round.

Club Facilities: The golf shop and clubhouse will be available at 6:30am. Breakfast and Lunch will be available at the player's expense starting at 7:00am.

Practice Range Facilities: Long Meadow GC does <u>NOT</u> have a driving range. The putting green will be available beginning at 6:30am.

Score Posting: All scores from individual stroke play events (qualifiers & championships proper) will be automatically posted to a player's Mass Golf/USGA Handicap Index by the Mass Golf.
