Format: 18 holes, stroke play qualifying. The top <u>12 qualifiers and ties</u> will move on to the championship proper at GreatHorse in Hampden, MA on June 11-13, 2018. The number of qualifying spots is subject to change based on any withdrawals prior to the competition.

Rules of Play: The 2016 Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the Mass Golf Hard Card. The Committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed at the championship site. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the Conditions of the Competition.

Policies & Procedures: Please refer to the Mass Golf Policies & Procedures.

Distance Measuring Devices: A player may use devices that measure or gauge distance only. Penalty for breach of this condition: Two stroke penalty for the first breach, disqualification for second breach of Rule 14-3.

Golf Carts: Golf carts are permitted for use during the qualifying round and are available at the player's expense - \$30.00. Caddies and push carts are permitted. As a reminder, carts are **NOT** permitted in the championship proper.

1st Tee Time: Play will begin at 8:00am, in groups of three, at ten-minute intervals, off the 1st and 10th tees. Please be sure to be at your starting tee at least 10 minutes prior to ensure that all proper instructions are received from the starter.

Tees: Approximate yardage for the Qualifying Round will be 6,800 yards (Red Tees).

Practice Round: A practice round can be scheduled (**up to 5 days in advance**) by calling the golf shop **(978) 610-2701** and introducing yourself as a competitor in the qualifying round or by emailing **golfshop@nashwtuc.com**. There will be a MANDATORY cart/trail fee of \$30.00 which includes access to the practice grounds up to 1-hour before your scheduled practice round.

Dates Available: May 14 (after 1pm), May 15 (after 1pm), May 16 (after 1pm), May 17 (after 1pm), May 18 (after 3pm), May 22 (after 1pm) & May 23 (after 1pm)

Club Facilities: The golf shop will be available at 7:00am. Access to the clubhouse and food & beverage services will be LIMITED due to ongoing clubhouse renovations.

Practice Range: Will be open and available at 7:00am.

Score Posting: All scores from individual stroke play events (qualifiers & championships proper) will be automatically posted to a player's Mass Golf/USGA Handicap Index by the Mass Golf staff.
