Format: 18 holes, stroke play qualifying. The top <u>12 qualifiers and ties</u> will move on to the championship proper at Belmont Country Club in Belmont, MA on August 6-9, 2018. The number of qualifying spots is subject to change based on any withdrawals prior to the competition.

Rules of Play: The 2016 Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the Mass Golf Hard Card. The Committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed at the championship site. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the Conditions of the Competition.

Caddies & Golf Carts: The use of golf carts and/or caddies is **NOT** permitted at qualifying rounds and the championship proper. Push/pull carts are permitted.

1st Tee Time: Play will begin at 7:30am, in groups of three, at nine-minute intervals, off the 1st tee. Please be sure to be at **your starting tee at least 10 minutes prior** to ensure that all proper instructions are received from the starter.

Tees: Approximate yardage for the Qualifying Round will be 6,100 yards (White/Blue Tees).

Practice Round: A practice round can be scheduled by calling the golf shop and introducing yourself as a competitor in the qualifying round: **(508) 757-0231**. Competitors must make a tee time in advance – no walk-up practice rounds will be permitted.

Dates Available: June 11th after 12:00pm

Club Facilities: The golf shop and clubhouse will be available at 6:30am. Breakfast will NOT be available on site.

Food & Beverage: Mass Golf will provide lunch for all competitors after the round.

Practice Range: There practice range will be open and available beginning at 6:30am.
