Schedule of Play/Format:

August 6th & 7th – stroke play (18-holes/day)

- The low 16 players will advance to match play competition on **Wednesday, August 8th**.
 - Any ties for the final Match Play qualifying place(s) will be determined by a hole-by-hole playoff.

August 8th – Round of 16 (a.m.) and Quarterfinals (p.m.)

August 9th – Semi-Finals (a.m.) and Finals [18-holes] (p.m.)

Championship Tees: Approximate yardage will be 6,600-6,800 yards (Black/Blue Tee Combo).

Rules of Play: The 2016 Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the [Mass Golf Hard Card](#). The Committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed at the Championship sites. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the Conditions of the Competition.

Caddies & Automotive Transportation: The use of automotive transportation and/or caddies will **NOT** be permitted. The use of pull/push carts is permitted and must be supplied by the competitor.

Starting Times (Stroke Play & Match Play): Can be found on the [Massachusetts Junior Amateur](#) home page. Please make sure to be at your starting tee at least 10 minutes prior to your starting time to ensure that all proper instructions are received from the starter.

Practice Round:

Dates & Times

- July 21st, 22nd, 28th, 29th & August 4th & 5th – After 2:00pm on each day.
 - 8 tee times will be available on each of the listed dates and will be available on a first come, first serve basis. Players will be paired accordingly in order to fill out a foursome at each available starting time. No additional practice round dates/times will be available other than what is listed above.
 - Competitors **MUST** schedule their practice round starting time in advance, no "walk-up" requests will be permitted.

Notes

- Please contact the Belmont Country Club pro shop – (617) 484-5360 – in advance to schedule your practice round.
- **NO** parents, guardians, spectators or caddies will be permitted on the course to accompany a competitor during their practice round.
- Competitors should arrive **no earlier than 30 minutes** ahead of the scheduled practice round starting time.
 - Competitors will be permitted to use the practice range and can purchase golf balls in the pro shop for **\$12**.
- Competitors may supply and use their own push/pull carts during their practice round.
- The Youth Locker Room will be available and beverage items at the 10th Tee Shack (**CASH ONLY**)
- Competitors are limited to **one** practice round. Only **one ball** may be played per competitor during their practice round.
- All competitors are expected to observe exceptional golf course etiquette – please **REPAIR ALL DIVOTS, RAKE ALL BUNKERS, FIX ALL BALL MARKS**.

Practice Facilities: The practice range will open each day 7:00am and will **CLOSE** after the last starting time each day. The practice putting/chipping green will be available throughout the day.

Food & Beverage: A luncheon (sponsored by Mass Golf) will be available each day for all competitors. Food & Beverage will also be available for parents and spectators in the clubhouse on Monday & Tuesday – buffet \$18/person **CASH ONLY**. Boxed lunches will be available (\$15/person **CASH ONLY**) on Wednesday & Thursday. The 10th Tee Shack will be open on Wednesday & Thursday – **CASH ONLY**. Breakfast services will not be available.

Prizes: The Junior Amateur Champion (14-18) will be presented the Charles E. Mason Trophy. The Pre-Junior Champion (14-15) will be presented the Joseph M. Batchelder Memorial Trophy as the low 36-Hole scorer at the conclusion of stroke play. Gold medals will also be awarded. Merchandise certificates will be awarded to the 16 Match Play Qualifiers and are only redeemable at the host site.
