## **Player Information Sheet**

Schedule of Play/Format: 54-holes - stroke play

September 12th & 13th - Rounds 1 & 2

A cut to the low 30 competitors & ties (or anyone within 5 strokes of the leader) will be made after 36-holes
September 14<sup>th</sup> – Round 3

Championship Tees: Approximate yardage will be 6,300 yards (Gold/Black Tees).

**Rules of Play:** The 2016 Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the Mass Golf Hard Card. The Committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed at the Championship sites. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the Conditions of the Competition.

Caddies & Automotive Transportation: The use of automotive transportation is permitted. Carts may be rented at the competitor's expense \$20 (CREDIT ONLY) – a maximum of two (2) carts per group policy will be enforced. Caddies and pull/push carts are permitted and must be provided by the competitor.

**Starting Times:** Can be found on the <u>Massachusetts Mid-Amateur</u> home page. Please make sure to be at your starting tee at least 10 minutes prior to your starting time to ensure that all proper instructions are received from the starter.

#### **Practice Round:**

#### **Dates**

- Based on Availability
  - Practice Rounds will NOT be available on Fridays or Weekends (until after 2:00pm).
  - You may be paired up with other competitors playing their practice round.

### Notes

- Please contact the Plymouth CC pro shop at (508) 746-7800 x4 to schedule your practice round.
- There will be a mandatory cart/trail fee of \$20 (credit only) per competitor.
- Competitors may warm-up on the practice range (limited to 150 yards) and practice putting green ahead of their practice round starting time.
- Only one ball may be played per competitor during their practice round.

**Practice Range:** The practice range will be open and available one (1) hour before the first scheduled starting time each day and is limited to 150 yards.

Food & Beverage: WEDNESDAY – A luncheon (sponsored by Mass Golf) will be available for all competitors from 11:00am-2:30pm.

THURSDAY - Food & beverage will be available at the player's expense in the clubhouse (cash or credit).

FRIDAY - A luncheon (sponsored by Mass Golf) will be available for all competitors.

Additional food & beverage items will be available for all competitors, spectators, caddies, etc. in the clubhouse (cash or credit).

The halfway house (10th tee) will be available throughout the week (cash or credit).

Breakfast services will NOT be available at the club.

Prizes: The Ted Bishop Cup will be presented to the Champion. Merchandise certificates will be awarded and are only redeemable at the host site.
