Schedule of Play/Format: 36-holes - stroke play

September 25th - Round 1

A cut to the low 70 competitors & ties will be made after 18-holes

September 26th - Round 2

Championship Tees: Approximate yardage will be 6,400 yards (Black/Blue Tees).

Rules of Play: The 2016 Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the Mass Golf Hard Card. The Committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed at the Championship sites. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the Conditions of the Competition.

Caddies & Automotive Transportation: The use of automotive transportation is permitted. Cart fees are included in the entry fee and a maximum of two (2) carts per group policy will be enforced. Caddies are permitted and must be provided by the competitor.

PUSH/PULL CARTS ARE PERMITTED BUT COMPETITORS MUST USE A PUSH/PULL CART PROVIDED BY PINE BROOK CC. NO OUTSIDE PUSH/PULL CARTS WILL BE PERMITTED. COMPETITORS WANTING TO USE A PUSH/PULL CART SHOULD RESERVE ONE (FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED) BY CONTACTING THE GOLF SHOP AT (781) 893-4820.

Starting Times: Can be found on the <u>Massachusetts Senior Amateur</u> home page. Please make sure to be at your starting tee at least 10 minutes prior to your starting time to ensure that all proper instructions are received from the starter.

Practice Round:

Dates

- Based on Availability (starting on September 6th and beyond)
 - You will be paired up with other competitors playing their practice round.

Notes

- Please contact the Pine Brook CC pro shop at (781) 893-4820 to schedule your practice round.
- There will be a mandatory cart/trail fee of \$26.25 (cash or credit) per competitor.
- Competitors may warm-up on the practice range and practice putting green ahead of their practice round starting time.
- Only <u>one ball</u> may be played per competitor during their practice round.

Practice Range: The practice range will be open and available one (1) hour before the first scheduled starting time each day and will close after the last starting time each day.

Food & Beverage: *TUESDAY* – A luncheon (sponsored by Mass Golf) will be available for all competitors from **11:00am-3:00pm** in the main dining room.

WEDNESDAY - Food & beverage will be available at the player's expense at **ONLY** the snack bar/10th tee (cash only). Food & beverage will NOT be available in the club house on Wednesday.

The snack bar/10th tee will be available throughout the week (cash only). Breakfast services will NOT be available at the club.

Prizes: The Frederick J. Wright Memorial Trophy and a gold medal will be presented to the Champion. Merchandise certificates will be awarded and are only redeemable at the host site.
