Player Information Sheet

Historical Context: Miss Eleanor W. Allen was twice the president of the WGAM serving from 1917-1920 and again from 1930-1933. She donated the trophy in 1938.

Format: 18-hole Four-Ball Stroke Play. Better Ball of partners played at 95% of handicap. Played in foursomes with tee times starting at 7:15.

Awards: Trophy will be engraved with the names of the gross winners. Ties will be decided by a match of cards in accordance with USGA recommended method. Prize Certificates (gross & net places) will be given out that must be redeemed at Red Tail Golf Club.

Rules of Play: The 2016 Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the Mass Golf <u>Hard Card</u>. The Committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed at the Championship sites. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the Conditions of the Competition.

Mass Golf Policies & Procedures: Please refer to Policies & Procedures and Pace of Play.

Golf Carts, Caddies and Pull Carts: Golf carts are included in the Championship entry fee. Players are <u>strongly encouraged</u> to use golf carts. Caddies and pull/push carts are permitted.

Time of Starting – Will start at 7:15 off first hole Please make sure to be at **your starting tee at least 10 minutes prior** to your starting time to ensure that all proper instructions are received from the starter. <u>It is a long cart ride from the practice area to the first tee</u>. Allow 10 minutes of travel time. **The clock at the 1st tee is the official time**.

Tees: Approx. yardage for Red Tail GC 5065 yards (Club's Blue Tees).6

Hole Placement Charts & Local Rules Sheets will be provided on the day of tournament.

Practice Facilities: The practice facilities will be open and available starting at 6amm The driving range tees will be MATS ONLY.

Weather Warning: We will blast a hand-held air horn.

Restroom Locations: Holes 5 & 14

Drinking Water: Water stations at 6 holes throughout the course. There will be a roving beverage cart.

Food & Beverage Services: A box lunch is included for all competitors. Other food and beverage services will be available

Scorecards: A side's score to count must be *individually identifiable*. Partners that do not make a score on any particular hole should mark an "X". Scorecards are to be exchanged and brought to the scoring area immediately upon completion of play. Scoring table will be on the back deck of the club house. Scores will be posted by Mass Golf.
