Championship Flight: 36 holes of stroke play, 18 holes each day. Approximate Yardage: 5637 yds

Silver Flight : 36 holes of stroke play, 18 holes each day. Approximate Yardage: 5400 yds

Jr./Jr. Flight: 18 holes of stroke play, 9 holes each day. Approximate Yardage: 1591 yds

Mite Division: 18 holes of stroke play, 9 holes each day. Approximate Yardage: 1109

Rules of Play: The 2016 Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the Mass Golf [Hard Card](#). The Committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed at the championship site. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the Conditions of the Competition.

Caddies & Automotive Transportation: The use of automotive transportation and/or caddies will **NOT** be permitted. The use of pull/push carts will be permitted.

Tee Times: Round 1 tee times will begin at 8am. Round 2 tee times will also begin at 8am and will be determined by round 1 scores. Please make sure to be at your starting tee **at least 10 minutes prior** to insure that all proper instructions are received from the starter.

Practice Facilities: The practice range will open each day 7:00am and will CLOSE after the last starting time each day. The practice putting/chipping green will be available throughout the day.
