Format: 54 holes, stroke play (18-holes per day), 150 +/- players, comprised of place-winners in qualifying rounds and those exempt from qualifying. The fifty (50) lowest scorers & ties or anyone within 7 strokes of the leader after 36-holes will continue play on June 12th.

Rules of Play: The 2019 Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the [Mass Golf Hard Card](#). The Committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed at the Championship sites. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the Terms of the Competition.

Golf Carts, Caddies and Pull Carts: Players may use caddies and/or pull/push carts during the Championship Proper. The use of automotive transportation is **NOT** permitted.

Starting Times – Round 1, 2 & 3: Can be found on the [Massachusetts Open](#) home page. Please make sure to be at your starting tee at least **10 minutes** prior to your starting time to ensure that all proper instructions are received from the starter.

****Shuttles will be available for competitors starting on the 10th tee, please allow for a 5-10 minute shuttle ride to the 10th tee****

Practice Range: Will be open and available starting at 6:30am each day.

Food & Beverage: Will be available for purchase throughout the event in the Golf House (cash or credit). The halfway house (10th tee) will also be open and available throughout the event (cash or credit).

Parking: Is **extremely limited** at Vesper CC, at times parking "on the island" will be limited to **COMPETITORS ONLY**. Please plan accordingly with caddies, friends, family, etc. as they will be required to park along Pawtucket Blvd.

Purse/Prizes: The Clarence G. Cochrane Memorial Trophy will be presented to the Champion and The Commonwealth Cup will be presented to the Low-Amateur. A professional purse of \$75,000 will be distributed to the low fifty (50) finishers & ties. Merchandise certificates will be awarded to amateur finishers and are only redeemable at the host site.
