Format: 18 holes, stroke play qualifying. The top <u>14 qualifiers and ties</u> will move on to the championship proper at Bayberry Hills Golf Course on August 6 - 7, 2019. The number of qualifying spots is subject to change based on any withdrawals prior to the competition.

Rules of Play: The 2019 Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the Mass Golf Hard Card. The Committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed at the championship site. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the Terms of the Competition.

Policies & Procedures: Please refer to the Mass Golf Policies & Procedures.

Golf Carts: Golf carts are permitted for use during the qualifying round and are available at the player's expense - \$19.00. Caddies and push carts are permitted. As a reminder, carts **ARE** permitted in the championship proper.

1st **Tee Time:** Play will begin at 7:30am, in groups of three, at ten-minute intervals, off the 1st tee. Please be sure to be at **your starting tee at least 10 minutes prior** to ensure that all proper instructions are received from the starter.

Tees: Approximate yardage for the Qualifying Round will be 6,200 yards (White Tees).

Practice Round: A practice round can be scheduled by calling the golf shop and introducing yourself as a competitor in the qualifying round: **(781) 828-4444.** There will be a cart/trail fee of \$19.00 for players during their practice round.

Dates Available: Call pro shop for availability

Club Facilities: The golf shop and clubhouse will be available at 6:30am. Lunch (Grill & Halfway House) will be available beginning at 11:30am in the clubhouse.

Practice Range: Will be open and available at 6:30am.

Score Posting: All scores from individual stroke play events (qualifiers & championships proper) will be automatically posted to a player's Mass Golf/USGA Handicap Index by the Mass Golf staff.
