Format: 18 holes, stroke play qualifying. The top **6 qualifiers and ties** will move on to the championship proper at Vesper Country Club on June 10-12, 2019. The number of qualifying spots is subject to change based on any withdrawals prior to the competition.

Rules of Play: The 2019 Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the [Mass Golf Hard Card](#). The Committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed at the championship site. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the Terms of the Competition.

Policies & Procedures: Please refer to the Mass Golf [Policies & Procedures](#).

Golf Carts: Golf carts are permitted for use during the qualifying round and are available at the player's expense - \$20.00. Caddies and push carts are permitted. As a reminder, carts are **NOT** permitted in the championship proper.

1st Tee Time: Play will begin at 8:00am, in groups of three, at ten-minute intervals, off the 1st tee. Please be sure to be at **your starting tee at least 10 minutes prior** to ensure that all proper instructions are received from the starter.

Tees: Approximate yardage for the Qualifying Round will be 6,300 yards (Gold Tees).

Practice Round: A practice round can be scheduled by calling the golf shop and introducing yourself as a competitor in the qualifying round: **(413) 447-8504**. There will be a MANDATORY cart/trail fee of \$20.00.

Dates Available: April 24, 25, 26, 29 & May 1, 2, 6 (after 11:00am)

Club Facilities: The golf shop and clubhouse will be available at 6:30am. Breakfast services will NOT be available. Lunch will be available beginning at 11:00am in the clubhouse (cash or credit).

Practice Range: Will be open and available at 6:30am.

Score Posting: All scores from individual stroke play events (qualifiers & championships proper) will be automatically posted to a player's Mass Golf/USGA Handicap Index by the Mass Golf staff.
