Format: 18 holes, stroke play qualifying. The top <u>12 qualifiers and ties</u> will move on to the championship proper at Vesper Country Club on June 10-12, 2019. The number of qualifying spots is subject to change based on any withdrawals prior to the competition.

Rules of Play: The 2019 Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the <u>Mass Golf Hard Card</u>. The Committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed at the championship site. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the Terms of the Competition.

Policies & Procedures: Please refer to the Mass Golf Policies & Procedures.

Golf Carts: Golf carts are permitted for use during the qualifying round and are available at the player's expense - \$27.00. Caddies and push carts are permitted. As a reminder, carts are **NOT** permitted in the championship proper.

1st Tee Time: Play will begin at 8:00am, in groups of three, at ten-minute intervals, off the 1st & 10th tee(s). Please be sure to be at your starting tee at least 10 minutes prior to ensure that all proper instructions are received from the starter.

Tees: Approximate yardage for the Qualifying Round will be 6,437 yards (Black Tees).

Practice Round: A practice round can be scheduled by calling the golf shop and introducing yourself as a competitor in the qualifying round: **(508) 945-0620**. There will be a MANDATORY cart/trail fee of \$27.00.

Dates Available: May 6, 7, 8, 10, 13, 14, 17 & 20

Club Facilities: The golf shop and clubhouse will be available at 7:00am. Breakfast will NOT be available on site. Lunch will be available at the player's expense (CASH ONLY).

Practice Range: Will be open and available at 7:00am – IRONS ONLY.

Score Posting: All scores from individual stroke play events (qualifiers & championships proper) will be automatically posted to a player's Mass Golf/USGA Handicap Index by the Mass Golf staff.
