Format: 18 holes, stroke play qualifying. The top <u>14 qualifiers and ties</u> will move on to the championship proper at Brae Burn Country Club on September 24 - 26, 2019. The number of qualifying spots is subject to change based on any withdrawals prior to the competition.

Rules of Play: The 2019 Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the <u>Mass Golf Hard Card</u>. The Committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed at the championship site. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the Terms of the Competition.

Policies & Procedures: Please refer to the Mass Golf Policies & Procedures.

Golf Carts: Golf carts are permitted for use during the qualifying round and are available at the player's expense - \$22.00. Caddies and push carts are permitted.

1st Tee Time: Play will begin at 7:30am, in groups of three, at ten-minute intervals, off the 1st & 10th tees. Please be sure to be at your starting tee at least 10 minutes prior to ensure that all proper instructions are received from the starter.

Tees: Approximate yardage for the Qualifying Round will be 6,300 yards (Blue Tees).

Practice Round: A practice round can be scheduled by calling the golf shop and introducing yourself as a competitor in the qualifying round: (508) 362-2606. There will be a MANDATORY cart/trail fee of \$22.00. Dates Available: July 30, August 1, 6, 8, 13, 15 & 20 (after 12:00pm)

Club Facilities: The golf shop and clubhouse will be available at 6:30am. Food & Beverage - lunch will be available starting at 11:00am at the players expense, breakfast services will be available.

Practice Range: Will be open and available at 6:00am.

Score Posting: All scores from individual stroke play events (qualifiers & championships proper) will be automatically posted to a player's Mass Golf/USGA Handicap Index by the Mass Golf staff.
