Format: 18 holes, stroke play qualifying. The top **17 qualifiers and ties** will move on to the championship proper at Woods Hole Golf Club on October 2 - 3, 2019. The number of qualifying spots is subject to change based on any withdrawals prior to the competition.

Rules of Play: The 2019 Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the [Mass Golf Hard Card](#). The Committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed at the championship site. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the Terms of the Competition.

Golf Carts: Golf carts are permitted for use during the qualifying round and are available at the player's expense - \$18.00. Caddies and push carts are permitted. As a reminder, carts **ARE** permitted in the championship proper.

1st Tee Time: Play will begin at 7:30am, in groups of three, at ten-minute intervals, off the 1st and 10th tee. Please be sure to be at **your starting tee at least 10 minutes prior** to ensure that all proper instructions are received from the starter.

Tees: Approximate yardage for the Qualifying Round will be 6,000 yards (BLUE Tees).

Practice Round: A practice round can be scheduled by calling the golf shop and introducing yourself as a competitor in the qualifying round: **(508) 358-4775 x5**. There will be a cart fee of \$18.00 for players choosing to ride during their practice round.

Club Facilities: Lunch will be available beginning at 11:30am.

Practice Range: There is no range on site.

Score Posting: All scores from individual stroke play events (qualifiers & championships proper) will be automatically posted to a player's Mass Golf/USGA Handicap Index by the Mass Golf staff.
