Format: 36 Holes, Stroke Play (18 holes per day). The low 70 scorers and ties will continue play on October 3rd. Starting times for Round 2 will be based on Round 1 scores and can be found at <u>www.massgolf.org</u>

Rules of Play: The 2019 Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the <u>Mass Golf Hard Card</u>. The Committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed at the championship site. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the Terms of the Competition.

Policies & Procedures: Please refer to the Mass Golf Policies & Procedures.

Golf Carts: Automotive carts are permitted during the competition (*cart fee is included in the entry fee*). Caddies and pull/push carts are also permitted.

1st Tee Time: Play will begin at 8:00am & 12:15pm, in groups of 3, at 10-minute intervals, off the 1st and 10th tees. Please make sure to be at <u>your starting tee at least ten minutes prior</u> to insure that all proper instructions are received from the starter.

Tees: Approximate yardage for the Championship Proper will be approx. 6,200 yards

<u>Notes</u>

- Please contact the Woods Hole golf shop at (508) 540-1899 to schedule your practice round.
 - Competitors <u>MUST</u> call ahead to make a tee time no walk-up times will be available.
- There will be a mandatory trail/cart fee of \$25 for everyone for their practice round.
- Only <u>one ball</u> may be played per competitor during their practice round.
- For competitors unable to take advantage of a practice round date listed above or wanting to preview the course just ahead of the championship, competitors/caddies may **WALK** (<u>no clubs</u>) the course on Tuesday, October 1st after 5:00pm.
 - The practice putting green/short game area will be available for competitors after 5:00pm on Tuesday, October 1st

Player Luncheon & Food and Beverage: Mass Golf will be providing a complimentary luncheon on Wednesday, October 2nd for all competitors between the hours of 11am-3pm. Additional food & beverage services will be available in the pro shop on a cash/credit basis starting at 10:30am.

Prizes: The Mass Golf Super Senior Amateur Trophy will be presented to the Champion. Merchandise certificates will be awarded and are only redeemable at the host site.

Club Facilities: The golf shop, driving range, and clubhouse will be available at 7:00am. Breakfast will not be available.

Score Posting: All scores from individual stroke play events (qualifiers & championships proper) will be automatically posted to a player's Mass Golf/USGA Handicap Index by the Mass Golf staff.
