Format: Teams of two; 18-hole Foursomes Chapman Style Format tournament; in two Class Divisions A-B (18.0 and under) and C-D-E (18.1 to 36.0). Ties will be honored for first place (low gross) in each class. Team handicap determined by adding 60% of lower course handicap and 40% of the higher course handicap. The 5/15/2019 handicap revision is in use. This format is covered under Rule 22. <u>Click here for more information</u>.

Historical Context of Tournament: This tournament originated in 1966 and is named after Mrs. Charles F. (Cris) Eaton who was twice the President of the WGAM from 1954-1957. She also initiated the New England Women's Golf Association to foster interstate competition.

Rules of Play: The 2019 Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the <u>Mass Golf Hard Card</u>. The Committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed at the tournament site. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the Conditions of the Competition.

Golf Carts, Caddies and Pull Carts: Golf carts are included in the entry fee. Players may walk & use their own pull carts. Caddies are not available from the host club.

Time of Starting: The morning shotgun will begin at 8:00am and the afternoon shotgun will start at 1:30 pm. Please be at your golf cart and ready to play fifteen minutes before start time.

Tees: All play from the Mass Golf Tee markers with approximate yardage of 5,705. Look for yellow lollipop markers by club's red tee markers.

Practice Facilities: There is no driving range at Pawtucket CC. There is a putting green and one hitting net near the first tee.

Rest Rooms: Comfort stations are located between holes 5 & 6.

Food & Beverage Services: There will be no coffee, beverages or food available at the club in the morning. A buffet lunch will be provided by Mass Golf for all competitors at the conclusion of golf for those in the morning shotgun and beginning at 11:30 for those playing In the afternoon start.

Prizes: The winning team(s) of this event have the lowest gross score and their names will be engraved on the permanent trophy. Ties will be honored. Merchandise certificates will be awarded for both gross and net-only redeemable at the host site.
