Format: 18 Hole Stroke Play. Competition will be 18 Holes at Stroke Play in four separate classes.

Class B (14.1 to 18.0)

Class C (18.1 to 21.0)

Class D (21.1-24.0)

Class E (24.1 – 36.0)

In the event of a tie for low-gross in any division, a hole-by-hole play-off will commence immediately following the close of competition (Holes Sequence: 1,9,1,9).

Rules of Play: The 2019 Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the [Mass Golf Hard Card](#). The Committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed at the Championship sites. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the Terms of the Competition.

- There will be a MANDATORY cart/trail fee of \$50.
- Caddies/Guests may join competitors during their practice round (\$50/player).

Course Set-Up:

Approximate yardage for each class:

- Course will be set up at approximately 5,200 yards.
- Gold/Red Tee Combo will be utilized.
- Par 36/35 - 71

Practice Range: Will be open and available starting at 10:30 AM on July 18th.

Food & Beverage:

- 11:00 AM Player Luncheon (sponsored by Mass Golf) will be available at the Tavern on 7.
- Additional Items:

The Tavern on 7 will be available at the player's expense (cash or credit) for breakfast and dinner.
