Schedule of Play/Format

September 8th & 9th - Rounds 1 & 2 (18-holes/day)

• A cut to the low 30 competitors & ties (or anyone within 5 strokes of the leader) will be made after 36-holes **September 10**th – Round 3

Championship Tees: Approximate yardage will be 6,800-7,000 yards (Red/Black Tees).

Rules of Play: The 2019 Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the Mass Golf Hard Card. The Committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed at the championship site and/or electronically in advance of the championship. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the Local Rules and Terms of the Competition.

COVID-19 Championship Guidelines, Policies & Procedures and Local Rules

Golf Carts & Push Carts: The use of automotive transportation (golf carts) is permitted. Carts may be rented at the competitor's expense \$30 (cash or credit) – per State regulations one (1) competitor will be permitted per cart. The use of push/pull carts is also permitted.

Caddies: Competitors may use a caddie during all rounds of the championship. Caddies will be expected to supply their own face covering, gloves & hand sanitizer. Caddies must not ride in a golf cart — carts will only be available/permitted for players - all caddies must walk. Players and caddies not adhering to this policy may be subject to disqualification from the competition per the Mass Golf Code of Conduct.

A player and caddie will **NOI** be permitted to ride in the same golf cart in any situation (members of the same household, family members, relatives, etc.)

Starting Times: Can be found on the Massachusetts Mid-Amateur home page. Players should only report to their starting tee immediately after the group in front of them has completely left the teeing area.

Please plan to arrive no more than 45 minutes ahead of your scheduled starting time.

Practice Facilities: The practice facilities will be open one hour before the first scheduled starting time.

Food & Beverage: TUESDAY – A luncheon (sponsored by Mass Golf) will be available for all competitors from 11:00am-2:30pm.

WEDNESDAY - Food & beverage will be available at the player's expense in the clubhouse.

THURSDAY - A luncheon (sponsored by Mass Golf) will be available for all competitors.

Breakfast (coffee & breakfast sandwiches) will be available for purchase each morning.

Additional food & beverage items will be available for all competitors, caddies, etc. (cash or credit).

Dinner service will also be available each day for all competitors.

Spectators: Per the State's (EEA) guidelines surrounding outdoor competitors and tournaments — NO SPECTATORS WILL BE PERMITTED at any point of the championship. This includes family members, relatives, members of the same household, general spectators, etc.

Prizes: The Ted Bishop Cup will be presented to the Champion. Merchandise certificates will be awarded and are only redeemable at the host site.
