Format: 18 holes, stroke play qualifying. The top **13 qualifiers and ties** will move on to the championship proper at Gannon Municipal GC on August 10-11, 2020. The number of qualifying spots is subject to change based on any withdrawals prior to the competition.

Rules of Play: The 2019 Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the [Mass Golf Hard Card](#). The Committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed at the championship site. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the Local Rules and Terms of the Competition.

Golf Carts/Caddies: Golf carts **ARE** permitted (one player per cart) and caddies are **NOT** permitted during sectional qualifying. Players may use push/pull carts at the host club(s) discretion. Carts are \$20.

1st Tee Time: Play will begin at 8:00am, in groups of three, at twelve-minute intervals, off the 1st tee. Players should only report to their starting tee immediately after the group in front of them have completely left the teeing area.

Please plan to arrive no more than 45 minutes ahead of your scheduled starting time.

Tees: Approximate yardage for the Qualifying Round will be 6,138 yards (Blue Tees).

Practice Round: Call the Golf Shop (508-398-9079) to schedule a practice round. \$59 rate

Club Facilities: Will be limited, please plan accordingly and bring your own drinking water. F&B will be available

Practice Range: No range on site.

Please note that a face covering/mask is required when using the practice range, practice putting green and any other practice facility.

Score Posting: All scores from individual stroke play events (qualifiers & championships proper) will be automatically posted to a player's Mass Golf/USGA Handicap Index by the Mass Golf staff.

Scoring: Mass Golf will be utilizing online/mobile scoring through the USGA Tournament Management App. Additional instructions will be provided in advance.
