Format: 18-holes, Gross Four-Ball Stroke Play. *Men and Women will play from different sets of Tees*. In the event of a tie, a hole-by-hole play-off will commence immediately following the close of competition.

Rules of Play: The 2019 Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the Mass Golf <u>Hard Card</u>. The Committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed at the championship site. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the Terms of the Competition.

Golf Carts, and Push/Pull Carts: Golf carts are included in the Championship entry fee - **Two players per cart will be permitted**. Players may also use push/pull carts during competition.

Caddies: Competitors may use a caddie during the Championship Proper. Caddies will be expected to supply their own face covering, gloves & hand sanitizer to be used throughout the competition.

Starting Times: Play will begin at 8:30 AM, in groups of four, at ten-minute intervals, off the 1st tee. Please be sure to be at the starting tee <u>at least 10 minutes</u> prior to ensure that all proper instructions are received from the starter.

Tees: Approximate yardages for the Championship will be provided at a later date.

Practice Rounds: Discounted Practice rounds are available to all competitors on a first come, first serve basis. The Cape Club has offered discounted rates on the following dates: <u>Oct 13-15, 19, and 20</u>. Competitors are encouraged to call the The Cape Club Pro-Shop at (508) 540-4005 to schedule a practice round tee time. Players will be asked to pay a mandatory trail/ cart fee of \$35.00 for their practice round.

Club Facilities: The golf shop and clubhouse will be open and available starting at 7:30 AM on the day of the Championship.

Food & Beverage: Breakfast items will NOT be made available for competitors. Mass Golf will provide a boxed luncheon for players to take advantage of before, during or after their round (depending on their scheduled tee time). Light food & beverage options will be available for purchase at the players expense - *water, soft drinks, snacks, etc.*

Practice Range:

The Cape Club driving range will be open approximately one hour before the first tee time (~7:30 AM) - *MATS ONLY*. The Cape Club does not have a short game area, and the Putting Green is for *Putting only*.
