**Format:** 36 Holes, Stroke Play (18 holes per day). The low 70 scorers and ties will continue play on September 29<sup>th</sup>. Starting times for Round 2 on September 29<sup>th</sup> (8:00am split tee start) will be based on Round 1 scores and can be found at [www.massgolf.org](http://www.massgolf.org)

**Rules of Play:** The 2019 Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the [Mass Golf Hard Card](#). The Committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed at the championship site. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the Terms of the Competition.

**Policies & Procedures:** Please refer to the Mass Golf [Policies & Procedures](#).

**Golf Carts, Caddies & Push Carts:** The use of automotive transportation (golf carts) is permitted. Carts are included in the Championship entry fee. The use of caddies, push & pull carts is also permitted.

*Note: No more than 2 carts will be permitted per starting time regardless of the number of players and/or caddies in a group. Caddies are permitted to ride in a player's cart if there is an available seat.*

**Starting Times:** Round 1 will begin at **8:00am & 12:15pm**, in groups of 3, at 10-minute intervals, off the 1<sup>st</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> tees. Please make sure to be at your starting tee at least 10 minutes prior to your starting time to ensure that all proper instructions are received from the starter.

**Tees:** Approximate yardage for the Championship Proper will be approx. 6,300 yards (Pocasset's Blue Tee's)

**Practice Round Information:** Please contact the golf shop at (508) 563-7171 and introduce yourself as a competitor to schedule a starting time – competitors **MUST** call in advance for a tee time - no walk-up times will be available.

- September 14<sup>th</sup>, 15<sup>th</sup>, & 16<sup>th</sup> after 1:30pm
- September 19<sup>th</sup> after 1:30pm
- September 21<sup>st</sup> after 1:30pm
- September 22<sup>nd</sup> after 1:30pm
- September 26<sup>th</sup> after 1:30pm

**Notes**

- There will be a **MANDATORY** cart/trail fee of **\$25 (cash and card accepted)** for your practice round.
  - Practice rounds are for players only
  - Only **one ball** may be played per competitor during their practice round.
- For competitors unable to take advantage of a practice round date or wanting to preview the course just ahead of the championship, competitors/caddies may **WALK (no clubs)** the course on Monday, September 27<sup>th</sup> after 5:00pm.
  - The practice putting green & driving range will be available for competitors after 5:00pm on Monday, September 27<sup>th</sup>.

**Player Luncheon & Food and Beverage:** Mass Golf will be providing a complimentary luncheon on September 28<sup>th</sup> for all competitors between the hours of 11am-3pm. Additional food & beverage services will be available in the clubhouse (cash/credit card accepted) starting at 11:00am. On September 29<sup>th</sup> for Round 2, lunch is on the players in the clubhouse (cash/credit card accepted).

**Club Facilities:** The driving range will be available at 7:00am. Driving range has a 200-yard maximum distance. Breakfast will not be available for competitors.

**Prizes:** The Frederick J. Wright Memorial Trophy will be presented to the Champion. Merchandise certificates will be awarded and are only redeemable at the host site.

**Score Posting:** All scores from individual stroke play events (qualifiers & championships proper) will be automatically posted to a player's Mass Golf/USGA Handicap Index by the Mass Golf staff.
