Format: 54 holes, stroke play (18-holes per day), 150 +/- players, comprised of qualified and those exempt from qualifying. The fifty (50) lowest scorers & ties or anyone within 7 strokes of the leader after 36-holes will continue play on June 16th.

Rules of Play: The 2019 Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the Mass Golf Hard Card. The Committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed at the Championship sites. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the Terms of the Competition.

Golf Carts, Caddies and Pull Carts: Players may use caddies and/or pull/push carts during the Championship Proper. The use of automotive transportation is NOT permitted.

Starting Times – Round 1, 2 & 3: Can be found on the <u>Massachusetts Open</u> home page. Please make sure to be at your starting tee at least 10 minutes prior to your starting time to ensure that all proper instructions are received from the starter.

Practice Facilities: Will be open and available starting at 6:30am each day.

Food & Beverage: Will be available for purchase throughout the event in the clubhouse or at the snack bar (located by the pool area) (cash or credit). Breakfast items will be available for purchase each morning beginning at 6am in the Oak Room bar and snack bar. Lunch will be available starting at 11am.

Parking: To assist with parking availability, please plan accordingly with caddies, friends, family, etc. and carpool if possible. Please follow all signage and directives of any parking assistants and police detail.

Purse/Prizes: The Clarence G. Cochrane Memorial Trophy will be presented to the Champion and The Commonwealth Cup will be presented to the Low-Amateur. A professional purse of \$75,000 will be distributed to the low fifty (50) finishers & ties. Merchandise certificates will be awarded to amateur finishers and are only redeemable at the host site.
