**Format:** 18 holes, stroke play qualifying. The top <u>14 qualifiers and ties</u> will move on to the championship proper at Westover Golf Course on August 17-18, 2021. The number of qualifying spots is subject to change based on any withdrawals prior to the competition.

**Rules of Play:** The 2019 Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the Mass Golf Hard Card. The Committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed at the championship site. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the Terms of the Competition.

Policies & Procedures: Please refer to the Mass Golf Policies & Procedures.

**Golf Carts:** Golf carts are permitted for use during the qualifying round and are available at the player's expense - \$20.00. Caddies and push carts are permitted.

1st Tee Time: Play will begin at 8:00am, in groups of three, at ten-minute intervals, off the 1st & 10th tee(s). Please be sure to be at your starting tee at least 10 minutes prior to ensure that all proper instructions are received from the starter.

Tees: Approximate yardage for the Qualifying Round will be 6,160 yards (Blue Tees).

**Practice Round:** A practice round can be scheduled by calling the golf shop and introducing yourself as a competitor in the qualifying round: **(978) 377-0655.** There will be a MANDATORY cart/trail fee of \$30.00

Dates Available: Weekends after 1pm

**Club Facilities:** The golf shop, clubhouse and locker rooms will be available at 7:00am. Lunch will be available beginning at 11:00am.

**Practice Range:** There is no range on site at Crystal Lake.

**Score Posting:** All scores from individual stroke play events (qualifiers & championships proper) will be automatically posted to a player's Mass Golf/USGA Handicap Index by the Mass Golf staff.

**Scoring:** Mass Golf will be utilizing online/mobile scoring through the USGA Tournament Management App. Additional instructions will be provided in advance of the qualifier.
