Schedule of Play/Format:

August 2nd & 3rd – stroke play (18-holes/day)

- The low 16 players will advance to match play competition on **Wednesday, August 4th**.
 - Any ties for the final Match Play qualifying place(s) will be determined by a hole-by-hole playoff.

August 4th – Round of 16 (a.m.) and Quarterfinals (p.m.)

August 5th – Semi-Finals (a.m.) and Finals [18-holes] (p.m.)

Championship Tees: Approximate yardage will be 6,600 yards (Gold/Championship Tees).

Rules of Play: The 2019 Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the [Mass Golf Hard Card](#). The Committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed at the Championship sites. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the Terms of the Competition.

Caddies & Automotive Transportation: The use of automotive transportation and/or caddies will **NOT** be permitted. **The use of outside pull/push carts is NOT permitted (TBD).**

Practice Round(s):

- Availability
 - Indian Pond CC – June 29th, June 30th, July 7th, July 14th, July 21st, July 26th
 - Tee times are subject to availability and players can book 7 days in advance
- Contact(s) – Competitors can contact the golf shop to schedule their practice round at 781-585-9117 ext. 100
- **\$26** mandatory fee, per player, for the practice round (**walking only**)
 - Cash or Credit card accepted

Notes:

- Competitors limited to one discounted practice round **PLAYERS ONLY NO CADDIES/PARENTS**
 - Only **one ball** may be played per competitor during their practice round.
- For competitors unable to take advantage of a practice round date or wanting to preview the course just ahead of the championship, competitors/caddies may **WALK (no clubs)** the course on Sunday, August 1st after 4:30pm.
 - The practice putting green will be available for competitors after 4:30pm on Sunday, August 1st. The practice range will be unavailable.
- Please note that we expect all competitors to practice exceptional golf course etiquette during all Mass Golf Championships. Competitors are expected to repair all divots & fix any/all ball marks.

Practice Facilities: The practice range will open each day 7:00am and close after the last tee time of the afternoon wave.

Food & Beverage: A luncheon (sponsored by Mass Golf) will be available each day for all competitors. Food & Beverage will also be available for parents and spectators (buffet only) at their own expense **CASH ONLY**. Breakfast services will NOT be available for players, parents or spectators.

Prizes: The Junior Amateur Champion (14-18) will be presented the Charles E. Mason Trophy. The Pre-Junior Champion (14-15) will be presented the Joseph M. Batchelder Memorial Trophy as the low 36-Hole scorer at the conclusion of stroke play. Merchandise certificates will be awarded to the 16 Match Play Qualifiers and are only redeemable at the host site.
