Format: Four-Ball Stroke Play. 18 holes played each day. In the event of a tie for first place, a hole-by-hole play-off will commence immediately following the close of competition at the Foxborough Country Club (Holes 1, 16, 17, & 18).

SUPER SENIOR DIVISION

All teams eligible for the Super Senior Division (both players age 65+), will be competing for BOTH the Overall Championship & the Super Senior Division Championship. Only one set of tees will be played by all competitors in the field.

Rules of Play: The 2019 Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the [Mass Golf Hard Card](#). The Committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed at the Championship sites. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the Terms of the Competition. A side's score to count must be individually identifiable. Partners that do not make a score on any particular hole should mark an "X".

Golf Carts, Caddies and Pull Carts: Golf carts are included in the Championship entry fee. Players are **strongly encouraged** to use golf carts during the Championship rounds. Caddies and/or push carts are permitted.

Starting Times: Can be found on the [Massachusetts Senior Four-Ball](#) home page. Please make sure to be at your starting tee at least **10 minutes** prior to your starting time to ensure that all proper instructions are received from the starter.

Practice Rounds: With this increase in demand for golf being seen across the entire state and given the size and scope of this event – we will not be able to offer practice round opportunities leading up to this year's Senior Four-Ball Championship. Without being able to provide ample and equal access to all competitors for practice round opportunities, this decision was made in the spirit of competitive fairness. Thank you for understanding and we do ask that competitors kindly refrain from contacting the host clubs to schedule a practice round.

Championship Tees: Approx. yardage for the Championship Courses: Foxborough Country Club - 6,300 yds (Blue/White Combo Tees) & Walpole Country Club - 6,300 yds (Blue/White Combo Tees).

Practice Facilities: The practice ranges will be open and available starting at 7:00am each day. The practice range will close each day after the last starting time.

Food & Beverage Services: A luncheon (sponsored by Mass Golf) will be available for all competitors at both clubs from approx. **11:30am to 3:30pm**, on **Tuesday, June 1st**. Additional food and beverage services will be available on June 1st & 2nd at the players expense (cash & credit accepted at Foxborough) (cash preferred & card accepted at Walpole).

Prizes: The James Shea Memorial Trophy will be presented to the Champions. Merchandise certificates will be awarded - only redeemable at the host site.
