## What to Bring

## Possible Assignments

- Live Scoring: Volunteer is stationed in an area on the course (4<sup>th</sup> tee, 7<sup>th</sup> tee, etc.) and interacts with players by collecting their scores for the last few holes.
- <u>Spotting:</u> Volunteer is stationed in an area where players cannot see their shots or in areas of heavy traffic. Volunteer will help locate balls in play when needed and handle any needed rules situations by calling for a staff member or qualified rules official.
- <u>General Assistance</u>: Volunteer can assist rules officials or staff with several different tasks. Helping players get to the tee on time, forward observing for a match, etc.
