Format: 36-holes, Stroke Play (18 holes per day). Competitors will be competing in two separate divisions (Championship & Tournament). In the event of a tie for low-gross in either division, a hole-by-hole playoff will commence immediately following the close of competition (*Sequence: TBD*). Playing Handicaps for the net portion of the Championship will be calculated based off of players [June 3rd, 2021 Handicap Revision](#).

Rules of Play: The 2019 Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the Mass Golf [Hard Card](#). The Committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed at the championship site. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the Terms of the Competition.

Golf Carts, Caddies, and Push/Pull Carts: Golf carts are included in the Championship entry fee. Caddies and push/pull carts are also permitted during the Championship proper.

Starting Times:

Round 1: Afternoon Shotgun - 1:00 PM

Round 2: Morning tee times (*based off Round 1 Scores*) off of the 1st & 10th Tees, in three-somes starting at 7:30 AM. Please be sure to be at the starting tee at least 10 minutes prior to ensure that all proper instructions are received from the starter.

Championship & Tournament Tees: Please see **APPROXIMATE** hole-by-hole yardages for the Championship proper below. Please note that these yardages are not final and are subject to change prior to the 1st Round of competition.

Practice Rounds: Practice Rounds will be available to competitors Monday* - Thursday leading up to the Championship proper, based on the club's availability. *Please note that Ledgemont CC opens for play at 12:00PM on Mondays. Competitors are required to call the Ledgemont CC Pro-Shop at (508) 761-3300 to schedule their practice round tee time. Players will be asked to pay a mandatory trail fee of \$50 for their practice round - this includes the use of a golf cart.

Club Facilities: The golf shop and clubhouse will be open and available to competitors starting at 6:30 AM for Round 2.

Food & Beverage: Breakfast items will NOT be made available for competitors on either day of the Championship proper. Additional food & beverage options will be available for purchase at the player's expense - *water, soft drinks, alcohol, snacks, etc.* If anyone has any specific food allergies or preferences - *please let me know ASAP so that something can be arranged.*

Round 1: All competitors will receive a boxed lunch prior to the start of the afternoon shotgun, and additionally, a dinner (sponsored by Mass Golf) will be available for all competitors starting at approx. 6:30 PM after the completion of Round 1.

Round 2: A luncheon (sponsored by Mass Golf) will be available for all competitors from approx. 11:30 AM - 3:00 PM.

Practice Range:

The Ledgemont CC driving range and practice areas will be open approximately one hour before the starting times for each round.

Score Posting: All scores from individual stroke play events (Championships & Qualifiers) will be automatically posted to a player's Mass Golf/USGA Handicap by the Mass Golf staff.

Prizes: The Edith Noblit Baker Trophy will be engraved with the Champion's name. Trophies will be given to the Champion of each division (*Gross*). Merchandise certificates will be awarded to top finishers (*Gross AND Net*) and are only redeemable at Ledgemont Country Club.
