Format: 18 holes, stroke play qualifying. The top <u>qualifiers and ties</u> will move on to the championship proper at the Wianno Club on October 4-5, 2021. The number of qualifying spots is subject to change based on any withdrawals prior to the competition.

Rules of Play: The 2019 Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the Mass Golf Hard Card. The Committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed at the championship site. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the Terms of the Competition.

Policies & Procedures: Please refer to the Mass Golf Policies & Procedures.

Golf Carts: Golf carts are permitted for use during the qualifying round and are available at the player's expense - \$25.00 (*Cash and/or Credit accepted*). Caddies and push/pull carts are permitted.

Starting Times: Play will begin at 7:30 AM, in groups of three, at ten-minute intervals, off the 1st tee. Please be sure to be at your starting tee *at least 10 minutes prior* to ensure that all proper instructions are received from the starter.

Tees: Approximate yardage for the qualifying round will be 6,100 yards (WHITE Tees).

Practice Rounds: Competitors are encouraged to call the Pro Shop at (508) 824-9144 to schedule their practice round tee time. Practice Rounds are available to competitors <u>Monday-Friday</u> and are based on the Club's availability (day to day). Competitors will be required to pay a mandatory trail fee of \$25.00 for their practice round.

Club Facilities: The golf shop and clubhouse will be available at 6:30 AM.

Food & Beverage: Breakfast services will **NOT** be available to competitors. Lunch will be available from the Club restaurant at the player's expense (*Cash and/or Credit accepted*).

Practice Range: Will be open and available to competitors at 6:30 AM.

Score Posting: All scores from individual stroke play events (qualifiers & Championships) will be automatically posted to a player's Mass Golf/USGA Handicap Index by the Mass Golf staff.

Scoring: Paper scorecards will be used as the official scoring method for Super Senior Amateur Qualifying.
