Format: 54 holes, stroke play (18-holes per day), 150 +/- players, comprised of qualified and those exempt from qualifying. The fifty (50) lowest scorers & ties or anyone within 7 strokes of the leader after 36-holes will continue play on June 10th.

Rules of Play: The 2019 Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the <u>Mass Golf Hard Card</u>. The Committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed at the Championship sites. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the Terms of the Competition.

Golf Carts, Caddies and Pull Carts: Players may use caddies and/or pull/push carts during the Championship Proper. The use of automotive transportation is **NOT** permitted. Longmeadow CC caddies may be available for the championship proper. Please contact John Riordan (<u>iriordan@longmeadowcc.net</u>) to secure a caddie for the championship proper.

Starting Times – Rounds 1, 2 & 3: Can be found on the <u>Massachusetts Open</u> home page. Please make sure to be at your starting tee at least 10 minutes prior to your starting time to ensure that all proper instructions are received from the starter.

Practice Facilities: Will be open and available starting at 6:30am each day.

<u>Longmeadow Country Club</u> Please note, the practice range at Longmeadow CC is limited to 175 yards.

<u>Twin Hills Country Club</u> A full-length practice range will be available at Twin Hills Country Club (700 Wolf Swamp Road- Longmeadow, MA). Approx. 5 minutes/2 miles away.

Food & Beverage: Will be available for purchase throughout the event in the clubhouse (cash and/or credit).

- Breakfast items will be available for purchase each morning beginning at 7:00am by the practice putting green (breakfast sandwiches, coffee, juice, etc.)
- Lunch (grill station) will be available on the "Back Patio" starting at 11:00am. Bar service will also be available.

Locker Room: The locker room will be open/available for all competitors, limited locker space will be available - if needed.

Parking: To assist with parking availability, please plan accordingly with caddies, friends, family, etc. and carpool if possible. Please follow all signage and directives of any parking assistants and police detail.

Purse/Prizes: The Clarence G. Cochrane Memorial Trophy will be presented to the Champion and The Commonwealth Cup will be presented to the Low-Amateur. A professional purse of \$75,000 will be distributed to the low fifty (50) finishers & ties. Merchandise certificates will be awarded to amateur finishers and are only redeemable at the host site.
