Format: 18 holes, stroke play qualifying. **The number of qualifying spots will be announced just ahead of the qualifying date and is subject to change based on any withdrawals prior to the competition.** Those who qualify will move on to the championship proper at Marlborough Country Club on September 19-21, 2022.

Rules of Play: The 2019 Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the [Mass Golf Hard Card](#). The Committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed at the championship site. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the Terms of the Competition.

Policies & Procedures: Please refer to the Mass Golf [Policies & Procedures](#).

Golf Carts: Golf carts are permitted for use during the qualifying round and are available at the player's expense – **EXACT CASH or CREDIT**. Caddies and push carts are permitted.

Note: No more than 2 carts will be permitted per starting time regardless of the number of players and/or caddies in a group. Caddies are permitted to ride in a player's cart if there is an available seat.

1st Tee Time: Play will begin at 7:30am, in groups of three, at ten-minute intervals, off the 1st tee. Please be sure to be at **your starting tee at least 10 minutes prior** to ensure that all proper instructions are received from the starter.

Tees: Approximate yardage for the Qualifying Round will be 6,800 yards (Black/Maroon Tees).

Practice Round:

Dates & Times (based on availability) - please note that available times may be limited due to the club's schedule

- Thursday, July 21st – after 1:00pm
- Tuesday, July 26th thru Thursday, July 28th – after 1:00pm

Notes

- Please contact the golf shop (978) 241-6710 in order to schedule a practice round. No walk-up times will be available.
- There will be a **MANDATORY** cart/trail fee of \$40/player for a practice round – **EXACT CASH or CREDIT CARD**
 - Competitors will be limited to one practice round and may be paired up with other qualifying competitors.
 - Only **one ball** may be played per competitor during their practice round.

Club Facilities: Food and beverage will be available at the player's expense starting at 10:00am at the snack shack/halfway house (cash or credit). The Grille Room will be available starting at 11:30am.

Practice Range: Will be open and available at 6:30am.

Score Posting: All scores from individual stroke play events (qualifiers & championships proper) will be automatically posted to a player's Mass Golf/USGA Handicap Index by the Mass Golf staff.
