Player Information Sheet

Format: 18 holes, stroke play qualifying. The top 15 qualifiers and ties will move on to the championship proper at Sandy Burr Country Club on August 10 – 11, 2022. The number of qualifying spots is subject to change based on any withdrawals prior to the competition.

Rules of Play: The 2019 Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the MASS GOLF HARD CARD. The Committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed at the championship site. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the Terms of the Competition.

Policies & Procedures: Please refer to the Mass Golf POLICIES & PROCEDURES.

Golf Carts, Caddies, & Push/Pull Carts: Golf carts are permitted for use during the qualifying round and are available at the player's expense - \$22.00. Caddies and push carts are permitted. Players must pay before your round.

Note: No more than 2 carts will be permitted per starting time regardless of the number of players and/or caddies in a group. Caddies are permitted to ride in a player's cart if there is an available seat.

Starting Times: Can be found on the <u>Massachusetts Amateur Public Links</u> Home Page. Please make sure to be at your starting tee at least **10 minutes** prior to your starting time to ensure that all proper instructions are received from the starter.

Practice Round Information: Discounted practice rounds will not be available. Competitors can book tee times (based on availability) by contacting the golf shop at (508) 285-2400 or by booking through the <u>Norton CC website</u>.

Practice Facilities: Norton CC does NOT have a Driving Range.

Food & Beverage Services: Food and beverage will be available at the player's expense starting at 10:00 AM.

Score Posting: All scores from individual stroke play events (qualifiers & championships proper) will be automatically posted to a player's Mass Golf/USGA Handicap Index by the Mass Golf staff.
