# **Player Information Sheet**

## Schedule of Play/Format:

August 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> - Stroke Play (18-holes/day)

- The low 16 players will advance to Match Play competition on Thursday August 4<sup>th</sup>.
  - Any ties for the final Match Play qualifying place(s) will be determined by a hole-by-hole playoff immediately following play.

August 4<sup>th</sup> – Round of 16 (AM) and Quarterfinals (PM)

August 5th - Semifinals (AM) and Finals (18-holes) (PM)

**Rules of Play:** The 2019 Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the <u>MASS GOLF HARD CARD</u>. The Committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed at the championship site. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the Terms of the Competition.

**Golf Carts, Caddies, & Push/Pull Carts:** The use of automotive transportation and/or caddies will <u>NOT</u> be permitted. Push/pull carts are permitted.

**Starting Times**: Can be found on the <u>MASSACHUSETTS JUNIOR AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIP</u> Home Page. Please make sure to be at your starting tee at least **10 minutes** prior to your starting time to ensure that all proper instructions are received from the starter.

Tees/ Approximate Yardage: Approximate yardage(s) for the Championship Proper will be 6,100 yards (NSGC's Blue Tees).

**Practice Round Information:** Discounted practice rounds will be available to all competitors at the discretion of the host club based on their availability. Competitors are required to call the Pro Shop(s) to schedule their practice round tee time (no walk-up times).

  - Practice rounds are available **<u>Tuesday Friday</u>** on the following dates:
    - July 19th 22nd, and July 26th 29th
      - Tee Times are subject to availability and players can book 7 days in advance
  - There will be a mandatory fee per player of **<u>\$25</u>** for their practice round.
    - Players old enough to ride may take a golf cart (18+). Players that are not old enough to ride must have a
      parent or guardian present if they wish to ride.
    - Cash and/or Credit Card is accepted.

### Notes:

- Competitors are limited to one discounted practice round PLAYERS ONLY (NO CADDIES/PARENTS).
  - Parents/Guardians are allowed to accompany their child during the practice round.
- The course will be unavailable on Monday, August 1<sup>st</sup>. Players unable to schedule a practice round will not be allowed to walk/preview the golf course. Players are not permitted to use the practice facilities on Monday, August 1<sup>st</sup>.
- Please note that we expect all competitors to practice exceptional golf course etiquette during all Mass Golf Championships and their associated practice rounds. Competitors are expected to replace all divots and fix any/all ball marks.

**Practice Facilities**: All practice facilities/areas will be available starting at 7:00 AM on each day of the Championship proper.

**Food & Beverage Services:** Mass Golf will be providing a complimentary luncheon each day of the Championship proper, beginning at approximately 11:00 AM. Additional F&B options will be available (Breakfast, drinks, snacks, etc.) for players/parents/spectators at their own expense.

**Prizes:** The *Charles E. Mason Trophy* will be presented to the Massachusetts Junior Amateur Champion. The *Joseph M. Batchelder Memorial Trophy* will be presented to the Pre-Junior Champion (low 36-hole scorer at the conclusion of Stroke Play). Merchandise certificates will be awarded to the 16 Match Play qualifiers and are redeemable only at the host site.
