Player Information Sheet

Format: 18 Holes, Stroke Play qualifying. **The Top 10-finishers** and ties will advance to the Championship Proper at Framingham Country Club (Framingham, MA) on September 7 – 8. *The number of qualifying spots is subject to change based on any withdrawals prior to the competition.*

Rules of Play: The 2019 Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the [MASS GOLF HARD CARD](#). The Committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed at the championship site. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the Terms of the Competition.

Golf Carts, Caddies, & Push/Pull Carts: Golf carts are permitted for the qualifying round. Competitors will be required to pay **\$20** for their golf cart on the day of the qualifier. Caddies, and push/pull carts are also permitted.

Starting Times: Can be found on the [MASSACHUSETTS SENIOR AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIP](#) home page. Please make sure to be at your starting tee at least **10 minutes** prior to your starting time to ensure that all proper instructions are received from the starter.

Tees/ Approximate Yardage: Approximate yardage for the qualifying round will be approx. 5,800 yards.

Practice Round Information: Discounted practice rounds will **NOT** be available to competitors prior to their qualifying round. Presidents GC is a public facility, and players will need to pay the daily fee/rate if they wish to book a tee time.

Practice Facilities: The practice facilities will be available starting at 6:30 AM on Monday, August 1st.

Food & Beverage Services: Breakfast and lunch will be available to competitors starting at 7:00 AM at the player's expense.

Score Posting: All scores from individual stroke play events (Championships and Qualifiers) are automatically posted to Competitor's Mass Golf/USGA Handicap by the Mass Golf Staff.
