Player Information Sheet

Format: 18 Holes, Stroke Play qualifying. **The Top 10--finishers and ties** will advance to the Championship Proper at Framingham Country Club (Framingham, MA) on September 7 – 8. *The number of qualifying spots is subject to change based on any withdrawals prior to the competition.*

Rules of Play: The 2019 Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the MASS GOLF HARD CARD. The Committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed at the championship site. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the Terms of the Competition.

Policies & Procedures: Please refer to the Mass Golf POLICIES & PROCEDURES.

Golf Carts, Caddies, & Push/Pull Carts: Golf carts are permitted for the qualifying round. Competitors will be required to pay **\$21** for their golf cart on the day of the qualifier. Caddies, and push/pull carts are also permitted.

Starting Times: Can be found on the <u>MASSACHUSETTS SENIOR AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIP</u> home page. Please make sure to be at your starting tee at least **10 minutes** prior to your starting time to ensure that all proper instructions are received from the starter.

Tees/ Approximate Yardage: Approximate yardage for the qualifying round will be approx. 6,000 yards.

Practice Round Information: A block of tee times has been reserved on 8/2 from 9:00 AM – 11:00 AM. Competitors will be required to pay the daily rate/fee for Seniors - \$39 – for their practice round. All other tee times can be booked based on the club's availability by calling the pro shop or using the website.

Practice Facilities: The practice facilities will be available starting at 6:30 AM on Monday, August 8th.

Food & Beverage Services: Grab and go items will be available at the player's expense. These items are limited – for both breakfast and lunch – so please plan accordingly.

Score Posting: All scores from individual stroke play events (Championships and Qualifiers) are automatically posted to Competitor's Mass Golf/USGA Handicap by the Mass Golf Staff.
