Player Information Sheet

Schedule of Play/Format:

- 36-holes, Four-Ball Stroke Play. *Super Senior Division* for competitors ages 65+. *Super Senior Division* competitors will also be competing for the overall Championship and will play from the same tees.
- In the event of a tie for first place, a hole-by-hole playoff will commence immediately following the completion of play (*Hole Sequence: Port Course – 10, 11, 18 repeated*).

Rules of Play: The 2023 Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the [MASS GOLF HARD CARD](#). The Committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed at the Championship site. It is the team's responsibility to know the Terms of the Competition.

Golf Carts, Caddies, & Push/Pull Carts: Golf carts are permitted for the Championship proper and were included in the entry fee. The use of caddies, and push/pull carts is also permitted.

Starting Times: Can be found on the [MASSACHUSETTS SENIOR FOUR-BALL CHAMPIONSHIP](#) home page. Please make sure to be at your starting tee at least **10 minutes** prior to your starting time to ensure that all proper instructions are received from the starter.

Tees/ Approximate Yardage: Approximate yardage for the Championship Proper will be approximately 6,300 yards for both courses.

Practice Round Information: Complimentary practice rounds will be available to all competitors *Mondays - Thursdays* at the discretion of the host club based on their availability. Competitors are required to call the Pro Shop at (508)-896-1716 and introduce themselves as a competitor to schedule their practice round tee time (*no walk-up times available*).

Notes:

- If players wish to take a golf cart during their practice round, they must pay a cart fee of **\$23.00** (*Cash and/or Credit Accepted*)
- Competitors are limited to one practice round.
- Only **ONE** ball may be played by competitors during their practice round.

Practice Facilities: All practice facilities/areas will be available starting at 6:30 AM on each day of the Championship proper.

Food & Beverage Services: Mass Golf will provide a complimentary luncheon during Round 1 of the Championship proper. Additional F&B items will be available (Drinks, snacks, alcohol, etc.) for players/caddies/spectators at their own expense – (*Cash and/or Credit Card accepted*). Breakfast services will be available to competitors at their own expense. Lunch will be available for purchase after Round 2 from the Club's restaurant for all competitors.

Prizes: The *James Shea Memorial Trophy* and *Super Senior Division Trophy* will be presented to the Champions. Merchandise certificates will also be awarded and are only redeemable at the host site.
