

## TRIBULATION

**That Has Descended Upon

WATERTOWN, Aug 28.—The Cambridge golf club, composed of well-known Cambridgeites, have for the past season been pling the golf sticks on their grounds, covering the Adams estate on Mt Auburn st, Watertown, and including many acres, giving a long run. To play golf well it is necessary that the course should be kept in good order, and the grass often mowed.

In England the grass on the course is kept close by a flock of sheep, which wander over it.

The Cambridge golf club took notice after their English coming and purchased a flock of 25 ewes in the east. They were shipped to Watertown and placed on the golf course, where they have eaten and grown fat besides keeping the course trim and in excellent shape. They have been guarded by a shepherd, but even with this precaution they have proved to be very persistent, and heretofore other methods must be introduced to keep the course in proper condition.

One evening a few weeks ago the shepherd left his flock to take care of themselves, and that very evening some one broke into the sheep pen and attempted to steal the entire flock, but while driving the sheep through Watertown he was seen by officer Conroy, and supposing that officer was about to arrest him, ran away, and although officer Conroy was somewhat surprised at the action of the crowd in charge.

The sheep scattered, and although he gathered what he could and kept them until their owners were notified, they failed to get the flock. The sheep were returned to the golf grounds, unmolested and peaceful, until yesterday, when they were driven to the slaughter house to be killed. Such action was made necessary on complaint of an agent of the society with the long name.
