Local Rules & Conditions of Competition

The Rules of Golf, Mass Golf Hard Card, and Terms of Competitions for Mass Golf Championships govern all play except as modified by the following local rules:

Scorecard: The Allendale CC scorecard is unofficial and has no status.

Tees: Play will be from the club's BLUE tee markers.

<u>Out of Bounds:</u> Defined by the inside edge at ground level of all white stakes, white lines, boundary fence posts, fog stripe, and club parking lot. When a boundary is defined by a stonewall, a ball is considered Out of Bounds when it is completely OVER the stonewall.

Hole #5 – Right (Stakes)	Hole #11 – Left (Stakes > Fog Stripe)
Hole #6 – Right & Behind Green (Stakes > Stonewall > Stakes	Hole #12 – Left (Fog Stripe), Behind Green (Stonewall)
> Stonewall > Fence > Stakes)	Hole #13 – Left (Stonewall), Right (Stakes)
Hole #7 – Right (Stakes)	Hole #14 – Left (Stonewall > Stakes)
Hole #8 — Right (Stakes)	Hole #15 – Left (Stakes > Stonewall), Behind Green (Stakes)
Hole #9 – Left of Green (Parking Lot, Driving Range (Stakes))	Hole #16 – Left (Stakes)

<u>Note:</u> A ball that crosses a boundary/public road and comes to rest beyond that boundary/public road is OUT OF BOUNDS, even though it may lie on another part of the golf course.

Red Penalty Areas: Defined by red lines. In the absence of a line, the stakes define the edge of the penalty area.

Hole #1 -Right of Green	Hole #11 – Left off Tee
Hole #2 – Left, Right (Starts ~125 yards from Green)	Hole #13 – Right
Hole #3 – Front of Tee	Hole #16 – Behind Green
Hole #4 – Right	Hole #17 – Left off Tee, Right
Hole #8 – Behind Green	Hole #18 – Left, Right
Hole #9 – Left	

Yellow Penalty Areas: Defined by yellow lines. In the absence of a line, the stakes define the edge of the penalty area.

Hole #4 – Fairway Crossing	Hole #8 – Crossing off Tee
Hole #6 – Fairway Crossing	Hole #12 – Crossing Near Green
Hole #7 - Fairway Crossing	Hole #13 - Crossing off Tee

Abnormal Course Conditions: All cart paths (paved or unpaved), roads (paved or unpaved), their immediate extensions/adjacent worn areas and white lined areas tying into cart paths. Relief may be taken under Rule 16.1.

Note: The Shed on Hole #5, and the Pump House between Holes #6 & #7 are Immovable Obstructions. Relief may be taken under Rule 16.1.

Ground Under Repair: Areas enclosed with white painted lines are considered GUR. Relief may be taken under Rule 16.1.

Hole #1: As an additional relief option for the Ground Under Repair right of the green, a player may use the nearest drop zone provided.

Integral Objects: All stonewalls, rock outcroppings and any section of a public road that is in bounds are integral objects, relief without penalty is NOT permitted.

<u>Pace of Play:</u> Pace for this round is 4 hours and 30 minutes. Please ensure that you are keeping within a hole of the group in front of you and within the time par printed on your scorecard.
