Local Rules & Conditions of Competition

The Rules of Golf, Mass Golf Hard Card, and Terms of Competitions for Mass Golf Championships govern all play except as modified by the following local rules:

Scorecard: The Cyprian Keyes GC scorecard is unofficial and has no status.

Tees: Play will be from the club's BLUE tee markers.

Out of Bounds: Defined by the inside edge at ground level of all white stakes, white lines, public roads, parking lots and boundary fence posts. When a boundary is defined by a stonewall, a ball is considered Out of Bounds when it is completely OVER the stonewall.

Hole 3 – Right Side (Fence/Stakes/Line/Road) Hole 10 – Left (Stonewall) Hole 14 – Right (Stonewall) Hole 15 – Right (Stonewall) + Behind Green (Road)

NO PLAY ZONES (Penalty Areas): Defined by red lines and identified by **RED STAKES with GREEN TOPS.** When a ball is in the NPZ or there is interference from the NPZ, the ball **MUST NOT** be played as it lies and relief **MUST** be taken under Rule 17.1e.

| Hole 8 –Behind Green | Hole 18 - Left off Tee & Crossing & Right |

Hole 4 - ** As an additional relief option for a ball crossing the edge of the NO PLAY ZONE behind the green between the two (2) BLUE stakes, a player may use the nearest of the two drop zones provided.

Hole 6 - ** As an additional relief option for a ball crossing the edge of the red penalty area between the two (2) BLUE stakes, a player may use the nearest of the two drop zones provided.

Red Penalty Areas: Defined by red lines. In the absence of a line, the stakes define the edge of the penalty area.

Hole 5 – Left & Right & Behind Green Hole 7 - Right Hole 8 – Right off Tee Hole 11 - Left & Behind Green Hole 13 – Crossing & Right off Tee Hole 14 - Left Hole 16 - Left Hole 18 – Behind Green

Abnormal Course Conditions: All cart paths (paved or unpaved), roads (paved or unpaved), their immediate extensions/adjacent worn areas, white lined areas tying into cart paths. Relief may be taken under Rule 16.1.

Hole 4: As an additional relief option (free relief) for the section of cart path (between the **BLUE** stakes), a player may use the nearest of the two drop zones provided.

No Play Zone(s): All cultivated/decorative flowerbeds are No Play Zones. Players MUST take relief under Rule 16.1f.

Integral Objects: All stonewalls, and rock outcroppings are integral objects, relief without penalty is NOT permitted.

Ground Under Repair: Areas enclosed within white painted lines are GUR. Relief may be taken under Rule 16.1

Pace of Play: Pace for this round is 4 hours and 30 minutes. Please ensure that you are keeping within one hole of the group in front of you and within the time par printed on your scorecard.
