Local Rules & Notice to Competitors

The Rules of Golf, Mass Golf Hard Card, and Terms of Competitions for Mass Golf Championships govern all play except as modified by the following local rules:

Scorecard: The Woodland Golf Club scorecard is unofficial and has no status.

<u>Tees:</u> Championship Division **RED** tee markers; Lowery Division <u>GOLD</u> tee markers; Women's Division <u>BLUE</u> tee markers.

<u>Out of Bounds:</u> (Holes: 1-5, 8, 10, 12-13, & 15-18) Defined by the inside edge at ground level of all white stakes, white topped stakes, white painted lines, boundary fence posts, tennis court fence posts, cart paths (see note below) and public sidewalks. When out of bounds is defined by a stonewall with fencing atop a stonewall, a ball is considered out of bounds when it is completely **OVER** the combination of fencing atop a stonewall.

Out of Bounds is defined by the inside edge of the cart path behind the Green on Hole #1 & Right of the Green on Hole #15.

Note: A ball that crosses a boundary and comes to rest beyond that boundary is <u>OUT OF BOUNDS</u>, even though it may lie on another part of the course.

Red Penalty Areas: (Holes: 2-4, 9, 11**, 14**, 15*** & 16) Defined by red lines. In the absence of a line, the stakes define the edge of the penalty area.

The red penalty area between the 11th and 14th holes is defined by the inside of edge of the stonewall (integral object)

The red penalty area right of the 15th tee is defined by the inside edge of the wood retaining wall

<u>Abnormal Course Conditions:</u> All cart paths (paved or unpaved), roads (paved or unpaved), their immediate extensions/adjacent worn areas, white lined areas tying into paths, and tree support braces. Relief may be taken under Rule 16.1.

Hole #7 – Protective fence left of Green – "line of sight/play" relief is **NOT** available; relief is for lie of ball, stance or area of intended swing and must be taken without crossing over, through or under the fence.

Hole #8 – As an additional relief option for the section of cart path (as well as the flowerbed abutting the boundary fence) between the BLUE lines, a player may use the nearest of the three (3) drop zones provided.

Hole #10 – As an additional relief option for the section of cart path between the BLUE lines, a player may use the nearest of the two (2) drop zones provided.

Immovable Obstructions Close to Putting Greens: For a ball in the general area, relief may be taken under 16.1b when both the ball and obstruction lie in an area cut to fairway height or less. The obstruction must be located: i.) On or within two club-lengths of the putting green, ii.) On the player's line of play, and iii.) The ball must be within two club-lengths of the obstruction.

Ground Under Repair: Areas enclosed with white painted lines are GUR. Relief may be taken under Rule 16.1.

No Play Zone(s): All cultivated flower beds/areas and the turf nursery right of Hole #13 are <u>NO PLAY ZONE(S)</u>. Players MUST take relief under Rule 16.1f.

Integral Objects: All stonewalls and rock outcroppings are integral objects, relief without penalty is NOT permitted.

<u>Pace of Play:</u> Pace for this round is 4 hours and 34 minutes. Please ensure that you are keeping within a hole of the group in front of you and within the time par printed on your scorecard.

<u>Playoff:</u> Any tie for first place – in any division – will be decided immediately by a hole-by-hole playoff (Holes: to be determined by the committee).
