Local Rules & Conditions of Competition

The Rules of Golf, Mass Golf Hard Card, and Terms of Competitions for Mass Golf Championships govern all play except as modified by the following local rules:

Scorecard: The Pocasset GC scorecard is unofficial and has no status.

Tees: Play will be from the clubs GOLD tee markers.

Out of Bounds: Defined by the inside edge at ground level of all white skates, white lines, and railroad fence posts.

Hole #2 – Behind Green (Stakes)	Hole #10 – Right (Stakes)
Hole #4 — Right (Stakes)	Hole #11 – Right (Stakes)
Hole #5 — Right (Stakes)	Hole #12 – Right (Stakes > Railroad Tie Fence)
Hole #6 – Right (Stakes)	Hole #16 – Right & Behind Green (Stakes)
Hole #7 – Right (Stakes)	

Red Penalty Areas: Defined by red lines. In the absence of a line, the stakes define the edge of the Penalty Area.

Hole #2 - Front of & Left of Green	Hole #10 - Front of Tee
Hole #3 - Front of Green, Right	Hole #16 - Left
Hole #8 - Front of Tee	Hole #17 - Right & Left

No Play Zone(s): The following areas are ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS defined as NO PLAY ZONE(S) – identified and defined by RED STAKES with WHITE TOPS. Players MUST take FREE relief under Rule 16.1f.

Hole #10 – Left - Driving Range (Stakes)	Hole #15 – Left off Tee - Driving Range (Stakes)
Hole #14 – Right - Turf Nursery (Stakes)	Hole #18 - Left - Driving Range* (Stakes)

*Hole 18 - As an additional FREE RELIEF option for a ball crossing the edge of the No Play Zone – or from the No Play Zone itself (between the BLUE stakes), a player may use the drop zone provided.

<u>Abnormal Course Conditions:</u> All cart paths (paved or unpaved), roads (paved or unpaved), their immediate extensions/adjacent worn areas and white lined areas tying into cart paths. Relief may be taken under Rule 16.1.

Integral Objects: All stonewalls and rock outcroppings are integral objects, relief without penalty is NOT permitted.

Ground Under Repair: Areas enclosed with white painted lines are considered GUR. Relief may be taken under Rule 16.1.

<u>Pace of Play:</u> Pace for this round is 4 hours and 30 minutes. Please ensure that you are keeping within a hole of the group in front of you and within the time par printed on your scorecard.
