Local Rules & Conditions of Competition

The Rules of Golf, Mass Golf Hard Card, and Terms of Competitions for Mass Golf Championships govern all play except as modified by the following local rules:

Scorecard: The Pocasset GC scorecard is unofficial and has no status.

Tees: Play will be from the clubs **GOLD** tee markers.

Out of Bounds: Defined by the inside edge at ground level of all white stakes, white lines, and railroad fence posts.

Hole #2 – Behind Green (Stakes)
Hole #4 – Right (Stakes)
Hole #5 – Right (Stakes)
Hole #6 – Right (Stakes)
Hole #7 – Right (Stakes)

Hole #10 – Right (Stakes)
Hole #11 – Right (Stakes)
Hole #12 – Right (Stakes > Railroad Tie Fence)
Hole #16 – Right & Behind Green (Stakes)

Red Penalty Areas: Defined by red lines. In the absence of a line, the stakes define the edge of the Penalty Area.

Hole #2 - Front of & Left of Green
Hole #3 - Front of Green, Right
Hole #8 - Front of Tee

Hole #10 - Front of Tee
Hole #16 - Left
Hole #17 - Right & Left

No Play Zone(s): The following areas are **ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS** defined as **NO PLAY ZONE(S)** – identified and defined by RED STAKES with WHITE TOPS. Players **MUST** take **FREE** relief under Rule 16.1f.

Hole #10 – Left - Driving Range (Stakes)
Hole #14 – Right - Turf Nursery (Stakes)

Hole #15 – Left off Tee - Driving Range (Stakes)
Hole #18 - Left - Driving Range* (Stakes)

***Hole 18 -** As an additional **FREE RELIEF** option for a ball crossing the edge of the No Play Zone – or from the No Play Zone itself (between the **BLUE** stakes), a player may use the drop zone provided.

Abnormal Course Conditions: All cart paths (paved or unpaved), roads (paved or unpaved), their immediate extensions/adjacent worn areas and white lined areas tying into cart paths. Relief may be taken under Rule 16.1.

Integral Objects: All stone walls and rock outcroppings are integral objects, relief without penalty is NOT permitted.

Ground Under Repair: Areas enclosed with white painted lines are considered GUR. Relief may be taken under Rule 16.1.

Pace of Play: Pace for this round is 4 hours and 30 minutes. Please ensure that you are keeping within a hole of the group in front of you and within the time par printed on your scorecard.
