Local Rules & Conditions of Competition

The Rules of Golf, Mass Golf Hard Card, and Terms of Competitions for Mass Golf Championships govern all play except as modified by the following local rules:

Scorecard: The Sandy Burr CC scorecard is unofficial and has no status.

Tees: Play will be from the club's BLUE tee markers.

Out of Bounds: Defined by the inside edge at ground level of all white stakes, white lines, fog stripe, parking lots and boundary fence posts.

Hole 8 – Right (Stakes)

Hole 10 – Left & Behind Green (Stakes)

Hole 9 – Left, Right, Behind Green (Fog stripe – Parking Lot – Stakes – Fog stripe) Hole 11 – Left (Stakes)

Red Penalty Areas: Defined by red lines. In the absence of a line, the stakes define the edge of the penalty area.

Hole 3 – Left, Behind Green Hole 11 – Over Green (No Play Zone)**

Hole 4 – Left of Tee Hole 12 – Left, Right of Tee(**No Play Zone**)**, Crossing Fairway, Behind & Left of Green

Hole 5 – Left Hole 13 – Left, Right, Behind Green

Hole 6 – Front of Tee, Right, Behind & Right of Green Hole 14 – Right off Tee & Right of Green (No Play Zone)**

Hole 7 – Left (*No Play Zone*)**, Right
Hole 8 – Left & Behind Green
Hole 15 – Left of Green***
Hole 16 – Left, Behind Green

Hole 9 - Left

Hole 7, 11, 12, & 14 - **The Red Penalty Areas identified by RED STAKES WITH BLUE TOPS are <u>NO PLAY ZONES</u>. Players must take relief under Rule 17.1e.

Hole 15 - *** As an additional relief option for a ball crossing the edge of the red penalty area BETWEEN the two (2) BLUE Stakes, a player may use the nearest of the two (2) drop zones provided.

<u>Abnormal Course Conditions</u>: All cart paths (paved or unpaved), roads (paved or unpaved), their immediate extensions/adjacent worn areas, white lined areas tying into cart paths. Relief may be taken under Rule 16.1.

<u>Hole 7 ONLY</u> - When any part of a player's ball touches part of the general area cut to fairway height or less, the player may take free relief once by placing the original ball or another ball and playing it from within <u>one club-length</u> of the original spot. The ball must be placed no nearer the hole, and within the General Area.

<u>Integral Objects:</u> All stonewalls, and rock outcroppings are integral objects, relief without penalty is NOT permitted.

Ground Under Repair: Areas enclosed within white painted lines are GUR. Relief may be taken under Rule 16.1.

<u>Pace of Play:</u> Pace for this round is 4 hours and 30 minutes. Please ensure that you are keeping within one hole of the group in front of you and within the time par printed on your scorecard.
