



**10th Massachusetts Young Golfers' Amateur Championship**

Local Rules & Conditions of Competition

The Rules of Golf, Mass Golf Hard Card, and Conditions of Competitions for Mass Golf Championships govern all play except as modified by the following local rules:

Scorecard: The North Hill Country Club scorecard is unofficial and has no status.

Tees: Play will be from the Mass Golf BLUE tee markers.

Out of Bounds: Defined by the inside edge at ground level of all white stakes, white painted lines, boundary fence posts and road/parking lots.

Hole #2/11- Behind Green (Road/Parking Lot)

Red Penalty Areas: Defined by red lines. In the absence of a line, the stakes shall define the margin of the penalty areas.

Hole #2/11 - Left near Green

Hole #3/12- Right

Hole #4/13- Right of & Behind Green

Hole #5/14- Infront of Tee & Left & Right & Behind Green

Hole #7/16 - Front off Tee & Behind Green

Hole #8/17- Right

Hole #9/18 - Right off Tee

Abnormal Course Conditions: All cart paths (paved or unpaved), roads (paved or unpaved), their immediate extensions/adjacent worn areas, white lined areas tying into cart paths. Relief may be taken under Rule 16.1.

Hole 1 - As an additional relief option for the Maintenance building (obstruction) right of the green, a player may use the drop zone provided.

Hole 3 - As an additional relief option for the Maintenance building (obstruction) left of the green, a player may use the **BLUE** drop zone provided.

Hole 3 - As an additional relief option for the fence behind the green, a player may use the nearest of the two **WHITE** drop zones provided.

Integral Objects: All stonewalls, and rock outcroppings are integral objects, relief without penalty is NOT permitted.

No Play Zone(s): All cultivated flower beds/mulched areas are *No Play Zone(s)*. Players MUST take relief under Rule 16.1f.

Ground Under Repair: Areas enclosed within white painted lines are GUR. Relief may be taken under Rule 16.1

Pace of Play: Pace for this round is 4 hours and 30 minutes. Please ensure that you are keeping within one hole of the group in front of you and within the time par printed on your scorecard.

Stableford Scoring: The Young Golfers Amateur Championship uses stableford scoring. Here is a guide.
