

2024 U.S. Amateur Final Qualifier Concord Country Club (Concord, MA) **NOTICE TO PLAYERS**



This information supplements the Championship Entry. See the USGA Hard Card for Local Rules and Terms of the Competition for USGA Championships.

SCORECARD: The Concord CC scorecard is unofficial and has no status

TEES: Play is from the WHITE USGA tee markers for the U.S. Amateur Final Qualifier.

INTEGRAL OBJECTS: All stonewalls and natural outcroppings of rock are considered integral objects from which relief without penalty is not permitted. The dumping area behind the 11th green is part of the General Area.

OUT OF BOUNDS: Defined by the inside edge at ground level of all white stakes, white lines, public roads and/or fog stripes, club driveway/parking area curbing and tennis courts/split rail fence posts.

Hole #10 – Behind Green (Fog Stripe) Hole #1 – Left (Tennis Courts) Hole #3 – Right of Green (Road) **Hole #11** – Right (Fog Stripe) Hole #13 – Left (Practice Range) **Hole #4** – Right of Tee (Fence) [split rail fence by green is an obstruction] Hole #8 – Right of Green (Road) & Behind Green (Driveway Curbing) Hole #14 - Left (Practice Range) & Right Hole #9 - Right of (Driveway Curbing) & Behind Green (Driveway Curbing) Hole #18 - Left (Practice Range)

RED PENALTY AREAS: Defined by red lines. In the absence of a line, the stakes define the edge of the penalty area.

Hole #1 - Right & Left of Green Hole #13 – Right off Tee Hole #6 - Right & Behind Green Hole #14 – Right of & Behind Green Hole #15 - Left & Right Hole #7 – Right

Hole #8 - Right & Left of Green

Hole #16 - Right off Tee, Left & ***Behind Green

Hole #9 – Left Hole #17 - Left & Right Hole #18 - Right off Tee

YELLOW PENALTY AREAS: Defined by yellow lines. In the absence of a line, the stakes, or split rail fence define the edge of the penalty

Hole #1 – Fairway Crossing **Hole #7** – Front of Tee **Hole #15** – Front of Tee **Hole #17** – Fairway Crossing

GROUND UNDER REPAIR: Areas enclosed with white paint. Relief may be taken under Rule 16.1b.

ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS: All french drains, cart paths (paved or unpaved), roads (paved or unpaved), their immediate extensions/adjacent worn areas and white lined areas tying into paths. Relief may be taken under Rule 16.1.

Hole #8: As an additional relief option for the section of cart path and/or split rail fence (between the BLUE stakes), a player may use the drop zone provided.

IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS CLOSE TO PUTTING GREENS: If an immovable obstruction (and a player's ball) is in a part of the general area – *cut to* fairway height or less – within two club-lengths of the putting green and within two club-lengths of the ball, and intervenes with the line of play, the player may take relief under Rule 16.1b.

NO PLAY ZONE: The turf nursery on Hole #17 (defined by WOODEN stakes) is a No Play Zone. Players MUST take relief under Rule 16.1b.

PACE OF PLAY: Pace for this round is 4 hours and 32 minutes. Please ensure that you are keeping with the group in front of you and monitor your pace by checking the times on your scorecard.

TIEBREAKING PROCEDURE: If there is a tie, a sudden death playoff will be held to determine the qualifying spot as well as the alternate positions. The playoff will take place on a hole or holes to be determinted.
