Local Rules & Notice to Competitors

The Rules of Golf, Mass Golf Hard Card, and Terms of Competitions for Mass Golf Championships govern all play except as modified by the following local rules:

Scorecard: The Country Club of New Bedford scorecard is unofficial and has no status.

Tees: Play will be from the Mass Golf BLACK Tee Markers.

Out of Bounds: Defined by the inside edge at ground level of all white stakes, white lines, parking lot curbing and boundary fence posts. When Out of Bounds is defined by a stonewall, a ball is considered Out of Bounds when it is OVER the stonewall.

Hole 3 – Behind Green (Fence)
Hole 4 – Right (Fence)
Hole 5 – Right (Fence/Stonewall)
Hole 5 – Right (Fence/Stonewall)
Hole 12 – Right (Fence)
Hole 13 – Right (Fence)

Hole 6 – Right (Stonewall) & Left (Parking Lot/Curbing)

Hole 14 – Right (Fence)

Hole 8 – Behind Green (Fence) & Left off Tee Hole 18 – Behind Green (Parking Lot)

Hole 9 – Right; starting at 200 yds. & Behind Green (Fence/Stonewall/Fence)

<u>Note:</u> A ball that crosses a boundary/public road and comes to rest beyond that boundary/public road is OUT OF BOUNDS, even though it may lie on another part of the golf course.

Red Penalty Areas: Defined by red lines. In the absence of a line, the stakes define the edge of the penalty area.

Hole 3 – Left & Behind Green Hole 4 – Left of Tee Hole 14 – Right

Hole #3: The red line on the cart path has no status.

Hole #3 & #17 - The red/yellow penalty area behind the 3rd & 17th greens extends to & coincides with the boundary fence.

Yellow Penalty Areas: Defined by yellow lines. In the absence of a line, the stakes define the edge of the penalty area.

Hole 16 – Right of Tee

Hole 17 – Front of Green & Behind Green

Hole #17 – As an additional relief option under Rule 17, for a ball crossing the edge of the yellow penalty area and coming to rest in the penalty area, a player may use the Drop Zone provided.

*** The Yellow Penalty Area behind the 17th green can be treated as a Red Penalty Area while playing Hole #3***

No Play Zone(s): All cultivated/decorative flowerbeds are No Play Zones. Players MUST take relief under Rule 16.1f.

Note: Areas containing just mulch are part of the **GENERAL AREA**.

Hole #9, #10, #11, & #12 - The areas identified by a WOODEN STAKE are a no play zone, players MUST take relief.

Hole #12 – As an additional relief option for the NO PLAY ZONE (identified by the WOODEN stakes) on the right side of the fairway, a player may use the nearest drop zone provided.

<u>Abnormal Course Conditions:</u> All cart paths (paved or unpaved), roads (paved or unpaved), their immediate extensions/adjacent worn areas and white lined areas tying into paths. Relief may be taken under Rule 16.1.

Hole #5 – As an additional relief option for the no play zone, cart path, scoreboard, & patio behind the green, a player may use the nearest drop zone provided.

Hole #12 – As an additional relief option from the section of cart path (between the BLUE stakes) behind the green, a player may use the nearest drop zone provided.

Ground Under Repair: Areas enclosed with white painted lines are considered GUR. Relief may be taken under Rule 16.1.

Integral Objects: All stonewalls and rock outcroppings are integral objects. Relief without penalty is NOT permitted.

<u>Pace of Play:</u> Pace for this round is 4 hours and 52 minutes. Please ensure that you are keeping within a hole of the group in front of you and within the time par printed on your scorecard.

Playoff: Any tie for first place will be decided immediately by a hole-by-hole playoff at Country Club of New Bedford (18, 18, & 1).
